

Brigadier Narender Kumar Dabas, is an alumnus of the University of Delhi and the Indian Military Academy. He was Commissioned in the 3 Sikh Regiment on 9th June 1984.

His journey in NCC started as a Junior Division (JD) Cadet from 1977-79 and a Senior Division (SD) Cadet from 1979-1982. He attended the Republic Day Camp both as a JD and a SD Cadet. As a JD Cadet he brought Laurels to the Directorate by winning the Gold Medal in Rifle Shooting and leading the Drill contingent. Delhi Directorate was on the Second Position.
